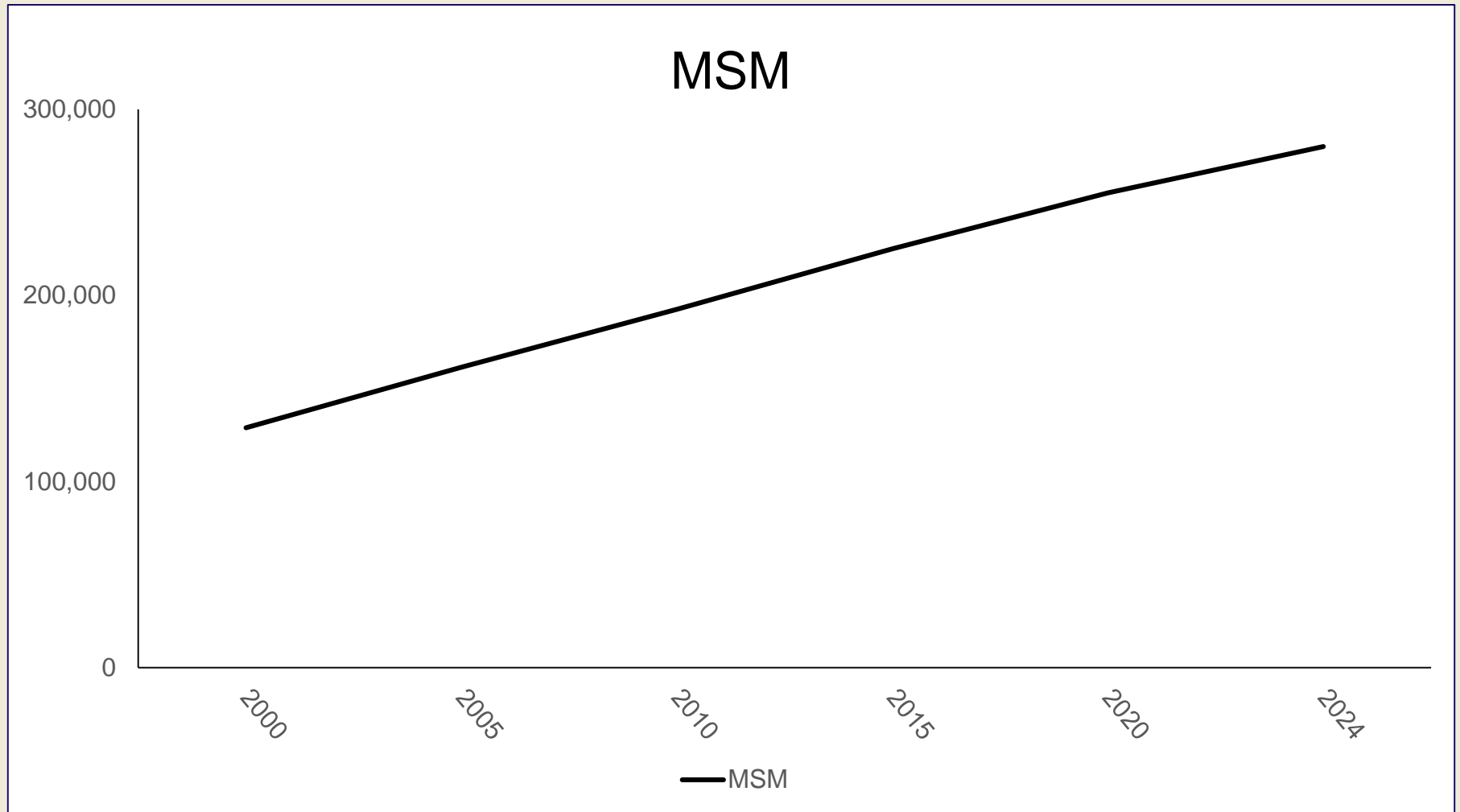


Initiatives
